

Know all Men by these Presents, That we *Margaret Sowash* *Joshua Budd*, *Joseph Budd* & *John Daily* all of the County of Westmoreland are held and firmly bound unto the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the sum of *five hundred* pounds to be paid to the said commonwealth: to which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally for and in the whole, our heirs, executors, and administrators, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals, dated the *twenty second* day of *May* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *two*

The Condition of this Obligation is such, That if the above bounden *Margaret Sowash* *administratrix* and *Joshua Budd*

administrators of, all and singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits of *Daniel Sowash* deceased, do make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits, of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands, possession, or knowledge of *them* the said *Margaret Sowash* and *Joshua Budd*

or unto the hands and possession of any other person or persons for *them* and the same so made do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, into the Register's Office, in the county of Westmoreland, at or before the *twenty second* day of *June* next ensuing; and the same goods, chattels, rights, and credits, and all other the goods, chattels, rights, and credits of the said deceased, at the time of *his* death, which at any time after shall come to the hands, and possession of the said *Margaret Sowash* and *Joshua Budd*

or unto the hands and possession of any other person or persons for *them* do well and truly administer according to law. And further do make, or cause to be made, a true and just account of *their* said administration at or before the *twenty second* day of *May* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *two* or when thereunto legally required; and all the rest and residue of said goods, chattels, rights, and credits, which shall be found remaining upon the said administration account (the same being first examined and allowed of by the Orphans-Court of the county of Westmoreland,) shall deliver and pay to such person or persons respectively, as the said Orphans-Court, by their decree or sentence, pursuant to the true intent and meaning of the several laws now in force in this commonwealth, shall limit and appoint. And if it shall hereafter appear, that any last will and testament was made by the said deceased, and the executor or executors therein named, do exhibit the same into the said Register's Office, making request to have it allowed and approved accordingly: and if then the above bounden *Margaret Sowash* and *Joshua Budd*

being thereunto required, do render and deliver the said letters of administration, approbation of such testament being first had and made in the Register's Office, then this obligation to be void and of none effect, or else to remain in full force and virtue.
