Henry Elias was born \_\_\_\_ 1751 in \_\_\_\_\_, Germany. He married Ann Neff (born \_\_\_\_ 17\_\_ in \_\_\_\_\_, Germany., daughter of \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ (\_\_\_\_\_) Neff) on \_\_\_\_ 17\_\_ in \_\_\_\_\_ Co., \_\_. A member of the M. E. Church. Died 08 Oct 1832 in his 81st year."
