2. Johannes/John Pontius, Sr. (P1D1D2) was born 18 Aug 1717 in Berlangenbach, Rheinland-Pfalz, Germany. Another source says he was born

in Alsace, France. He was christened 21 Aug 1717. He came to America from Rotterdam, Holland, as a part of the Huguenot immigrations, qualifying in Philadelphia at age 20 on 09 Sep 1738 aboard the ship "Glasgow". He took the Oath of Allegiance to the English king upon his arrival. He may have lived in Montgomery Co., PA. before he settled in Tulpehocken Twp., Berks Co. (then Lancaster Co.), PA. He married Anna Catherine Zeller/Sellaire (P1D1D2/W/, born ____ (c) 1722 in Livingston Valley, NY. or Berks Co., PA., daughter of Jean Henri (Johan Heinrich) and Anna Maria (Perigal or Von Breugal) Zeller) on 14 Jan 1743 in Tulpehocken Twp., Berks Co., PA. by Reverend John Casper Stoever. John was listed as "of Swatara" at the time of his marriage.

John was a plaintiff in the March 1744 term of court of Berks and Montgomery Co., PA. Johannes "had Heinrich Keller, heoman, of Upper Salford Twp., Philadelphia Co., summoned to answer his charges. Keller had borrowed 21 pounds from Pontius, giving him a promisory note on 16 Nov 1743, but afterwards refused payment. Pontius sued him for damages of 10 pounds, so it would appear that Keller repaid only half of the sum borrowed" (Gerberich). The court records do not indicate an outcome.

John Pontsius was taxed in Berks Co., PA. in 1753 and 1754. He appeared as John Poncius in 1757. He paid three pounds in 1759. He was naturalized in Tulpehocken Twp., Berks Co., PA. on 21 Mar 1762. He paid five pounds in taxes in 1767 for 50 acres, 2 horses, 2 cows, and 1 sheep. He was rated on 100 acres of land and paid taxes four pounds in 1768. John did not appear as a grantee or grantor in Berks Co. records. He was issued a warrent for 114.133 acres in Berks County on 18 Oct 1770. He had a tract a short distance northeast of Rehrersberg in Tulpehocken Twp. surveyed, but apparently sold his interest before a patent was issued.

John Pontius of Berks Co., PA., yeoman, paid 900 pounds on 15 Mar 1774 to John Phillip and Eleanor DeHaas of Lancaster (?) Co., PA. for land known as the Bucher/Bougher tract. It contained 619 3/4 acres in Buffalo Valley (then Northumberland Co., now Union) next to the land of Captain Green and Ensign Piper. The land was patented to DeHaas on 07 Mar 1774. The deed was recorded 27 Aug 1791. In 1775 John was taxed for 20 acres (of cleared land ?), four horses, and four cows. He paid taxes on 410 acres in 1781 and 1782. He seems to have passed on the land to his sons as he paid no taxes thereafter.

He is said to have served in the civil service as a private in the Revolutionary War.

A Hannes Pontzius took the Oath of Allegiance on 23 May 1778 in Berks Co., PA., but this may have been John Pontius, Jr.

There is a family tradition that John offered a tract of land for a Lutheran and Reformed Church and Cemetery. However, it was built further east of Martin Dreisbach's land. When the Dreisbach Church was built in 1788, a John Pontius was a Reformed member. John also set aside land for a school and a cemetery on the south side of the Bucher tract.

His sons Frederick and Hannickel (John Nicholas) had agreed on 27 Nov 1788 to pay 650 pounds to their brothers, 450 pounds to their sisters, and to provide food and supplies to John and Catherine in return for John's land. The agreements were recorded 16 Jun 1797. On 26 Dec 1788, John and Catherine deeded 206½ acres to Nicholas Pontius for 636 pounds. This land was known as the Upper Tract. It was located next to Frederick Pontius' land, the schoolhouse lot, and the Limestone Hill. In a deed of 24 Dec

1788 John and Catherine transferred 280 acres known as the Lower Tract to Henry Pontius for 300 pounds. They also conveyed 205 acres to Frederick Pontius for 300 pounds. On 31 Aug 1791, John released these tracts of land to his sons.

In the 1790 Northumberland Co., PA. census, John and Catherine were living alone, probably east of Mifflinburg. John made his will on 16 Jun 1792 in Northumberland (now Union) Co., PA. He died ____ 179_ (1792-1794 when the will was probated) in Buffalo Twp., Union Co., PA. He left a legacy to his daughter Mary Welker and her children.

Anna Catherine died ____ 17__ (c 1795) in Buffalo Twp., Union Co., PA. John and Catherine were probably buried in the Pontius Cemetery east of Mifflinberg, Union Co., PA. though their graves are no longer marked.

On 03 Jun 1805 Henry Pontius, Andrew Pontius, John Pontius, George Pontius, Mary Welker, Catherina and Michael Emrich, and Elizabeth and George Youngman released and quit claimed their interest of the estate to Nicholas Pontius

John's sons Henry, Andrew, Peter, Nicklas and John, Jr. all served in the Revolutionary War.
