"During the Huguenot persecutions in France, some of these people by the name of Ruby emigrated to England to escape the persecution. Then after many years residence in England, two brothers named John and Edward came to America and settled in Maryland." Samuel G. Ruby (R1A1B3) located a coat of arms for a Ruby family while serving as consul in Belfast, Ireland. It included the motto: La vray amour est toujours vive et ne meurt point par le trépas. (True love is always alive and does not die with death.) The French name was spelled Rubis or Rhubia.

Another source states he came to America in 1700. He served a sentence of fourteen years before he was freed. Thomas was in Nine Run Hundred from 1772-1781 when court records state that John Ruby and he did not take the Oath of Fidelity and Support to the State of Maryland. In 1778 he did sign the Oath. John was converted to the Methodist Church in Baltimore Co., MD. A John Ruby appears in the 1790 Baltimore Co., MD. census with 5 sons and two daughters under the age of 16. He received a warrent of 400 acres of land in Bedford Co., PA. on 02 Apr 1794 and for 100 more acres on 10 Apr 1794 (PA. Archives Series III Volume XXV page 616). Apparently his sons Thomas and George Ruby (as well as a Mrs. Sarah Ruby) appear in the 1810 Allegany Co., MD. census. In 1815 he bought land in Allegany Co., MD. Thomas and John Ruby, Sr. appeared in the 1820 Allegany Co., MD. census. John's other older sons John and Edward were said to have gone to Pennsylvania for a while. He sold his land in 1827 and moved to Harrison Co., OH. In the 1830 Harrison Co., OH. Moorefield Twp. (p 192) census, John Ruby Jr. (age 40-50) was listed with one male and one female, both age 70-80 which would seem to be his parents. John died \_\_\_ \_\_\_ 1834 in \_\_\_\_\_ Co., OH. His will was written 07 Feb 1834 and probated 23 Jun 1834. His will named only three children by name: Thomas who behaved unseemly, Benjamin who was deaf and dumb, and Betsy who was to take care of Benjamin and receive the farm after Benjamin's death. The will hints there were other children as it stated that they may have as much as Thomas

They may be the John Ruby in Harrison Co., OH. in 1840 with 1 male 60-70, 1 male 20-30, 1 male 15-20, 1 female 60-70, and 1 female 15-20. They were in Holmes Co., OH. in 1850. The family moved from Old Town, MD. to Harrison Co., OH. In 1835 they moved to Holmes Co., OH. The family moved on to Jackson Co., IN. in 1851. In 1859 they moved to a farm three miles southwest of Winterset, IA. where some of their children had already moved. In 1870 they sold their farm and moved into Winterset, IA. Mary died of a stroke on 09 Apr 1880 in Winterset, Madison Co., IA. Isaac died at the age of 92y, 10d on 22 Sep 1894 in Winterset, Madison Co., IA. They were buried in Winterset, Madison Co., IA. He assisted with the surveying the town site and was on the committee to select the name of the town. In 1894, Martha and the girls were living in Denver, CO. while Jacob was farming their homestead near Great Bend, KS. At the time, he was living in a dug-out. They divorced before 1900. He married Esther Elizabeth Hyskell (R1A1C2/W/, born 24 Apr 1837 in Warriors Mark, Huntingdon Co., PA., daughter of Jacob and Mary Ann (Beyer) Hyskell) on 03 May 1860 in Madison Co., IA. by W. S. Peterson, MG. Esther's family came to Madison Co., IA. with her family in the 1856. She taught one of the first terms of log school that was called Quail Trap in the District 1. She had to walk two and one-half miles to and from school each day.

John enlisted with his cousin John Wesley Ruby (R1A1C8) in Company I of the Fourth Iowa Cavalry on 09 Oct 1861 as a Bugler. While he was gone, Esther made her home with her father Jacob Hyskell in Winterset, IA. John was mustered as a private on 05 Dec 1861. He was listed as 5' 8" tall, hazel eyes, and auburn colored hair. He was treated for intestinal fever, dysentery, and a sprained ankle. He re-enlisted on 01 Jan 1864. In August of 1864 while at the Oxford and Holly Springs Campaigns, he suffered injuries to his eyes, apparently from the heat and gun powder while standing too near a cannon. He was sent to a convalescent camp in Memphis, TN. He returned to his regiment in Nov 1864. He was mustered out 08 Aug 1865 in Atlanta, GA. By 1900 he was totally blind in the left eye (it was removed in 1884) and nearly blind in the right eye. John kept a diary of his war years. The original diary was in the possession of Elizabeth Dawgs in Hays, Kansas in 1995. There are several known copies.

Upon his return, he learned the harness making trade, but lost all of his tools when the shop burned. He farmed, but the work proved too much for his health.

John rented his father's dairy farm in section 32 of Union Twp., Madison Co., IA. from 1872 until 1879 when they sold the farm. Esther's health had failed because of too much work. At the time they were milking fifty cows. Because John was not to do anything that would "warm his blood" that might inflame his eyes, they had kept a hired man (Charlie Thompson and later Frank Wilson) and a hired girl all the time. They churned butter using a dog and made cheese during the summer months when they had to deliver milk night and morning.

Frank Wilson, the hired man, went to Kansas to stake out a claim in 1878. Then the Ruby family followed to the Slate Community, Alcona Twp., Rooks Co., Kansas in Oct 1879 with three teams of horses, two Schutler wagons, and an old Iron Express wagon which had formerly been a stagecoach with the American Stage Company. It had been remodeled and fitted with running gears. This wagon pulled a dump cart that was filled with furniture to which was tied a stubborn old mule. John drove the first wagon with

Esther and Jessie. Emma (then 18) drove the second along with Cora. Ernest drove the third with Clyde and Bert. Three other wagons of travelers made up the rest of their party. They crossed the Missouri River on a ferry boat, landing in Brownsville, NE. Frank Wilson settled in Burr Oak, KS. where the Ruby family visited John Wesley Ruby, a second cousin (R1A1C8), who wanted John to stay and settle in Jewell County. However, the family went on. They also stopped in Kirwin, KS. to visit Margaret (Ruby) Alexander (R1A1C9), a brother to John Wesley Ruby. They arrived in Stockton on 20 Oct 1879 and bought supplies from the Randall Brothers' Store. After asking directions, they headed to the homestead. In 1940, Emma (Ruby) Pepper wrote:

In 1879 when we reached the place where we were to make our home, there wasn't a house or a tree in sight, only buffalo grass dotted with buffalo bones. I will never forget how mother sat in the wagon with tears rolling down her cheeks and said, "To think that I ever brought my family to a place like this." It did not take father very long to make a sod dugout. Mother tacked muslin on the walls and ceiling, put rag carpets on the dirt floor and we were comfortable and happy.

Esther soon was reminded of the fact that she too had come to Iowa as a child from Pennsylvania with her parents when it was barren and she had suffered no harm for the experience.

John decided to build a sod house, but the land had too much blue shale in it to farm. Charlie Thompson, the former hired hand who had the neighboring claim, offered to trade claims which they did. Charlie then dug a hole in the shale hill to live in. When he learned that he couldn't marry Emma, the oldest daughter, he left the area. Meanwhile the Ruby family lived in a sod hut until the house could be built, complete with stone walls and a wooden floor.

The first school was taught in the slate dugout by A. D. Jones, who continued to teach in the area for quite a few years. He had left his wife in Chicago while he came out to the new settlements.

In early February of 1881, John decided to take a load of sorghum molasses that they had made the previous fall to Great Bend, KS. On the third day out, it clouded up and started to mist. When he arrived in Great Bend, it turned to snow and kept snowing for three days. The ground was soaked up and then covered with one to two feet of snow. He could not start for home for five or six weeks. Needless to say, the family was more than a little worried. No word came, though they checked the post office regularly. Finally after three weeks, they received a card that he had arrived and would start home with the supplies he had traded for as soon as he could. The family was short on food and fuel, resorting to corn stocks and hay when the cow chips ran out. A neighbor gave them a sack of corn meal.

John traded farms again to get closer to the school, within one mile. There was no well water, so it had to be carried in and the family had to live in a one-room sod house again.

John served as Slate postmaster for several years out of one corner of the sod home. He also kept a few supplies for sale for the neighbors. When the local sod school

became too small for the Methodist Church meeting, John and Esther held them in their house. At times the number grew to 85 attending.

In 1883 or 1884, the region had a scare from a band of Indians who had left the reservation and were headed to the Dakotas where they had lived before they were moved. Rumor had it that they had killed a lot of people along the way. Most of the story was made up by the local mail carrier, but the settlers were a little more cautious after that.

About 1884 he was asked by some neighbors to help thresh. The dust and dirt caused his eyeball to burst. He was taken to a nearby farmhouse where the doctor removed the eyeball.

They farmed the homestead until 1888 when they rented the farm out and moved to Stockton, KS. to a house on East Main Street. He started a livery business but had to give it up because of his failing eyesight. On 16 Aug 1900 John bought lots 8, 10, and 12 in Block 1 North in the Saruers Addition on East Main Street. On 16 Jan 1901 he bought lots 14, 16, and the east half of 18 in Block 1 North of the Saruers Addition. He later sold all except lots 10, 12, and 14 where they lived. His son Ernest lived across the street from them.

One day some friends asked him to walk to the depot to send a telegram. The day was warm, apparently causing his remaining eye to burst. It was removed by the doctor.

John died of a throat illness and a heart attack on 03 Feb 1911 in Stockton, Rooks Co., KS. Esther died of apoplexy (paralysis) on 24 May 1920 in Stockton, Rooks Co., KS. They were buried in Stockton, Rooks Co., KS.

They had six children: A. Emma Rosalie (Ruby) Pepper B. Ernest Ruby C. Cora May (Ruby) Reynolds D. Bertram Hyskell Ruby E. Clyde Orville Ruby F. Jessie Adaline (Ruby) Marshall.

A. Emma Rosalie Ruby (R1A1C2A) was born 17 Jan 1862 near Winterset, Madison Co., IA. She married Isaac Newton Pepper (R1A1C2A/H/, born 08 or 11 Apr 1850 (neither date corresponds with his age at death) in Wysox, Bradford Co., PA., son of William and Sarah (Parks) Pepper) on 01 Nov 1882 in Rooks Co., KS. Isaac was said to have served as a private in Company B of the 97th Pennsylvania Infantry during the Civil War; however, he would have only been 15 at the end of the war. Emma taught school in the area, at first in her father's house with her brothers and sisters as half the class. They farmed for four years until they moved to Stockton and built a brick house on East Main Street. Isaac sold real estate. About 1902 the family moved to Kansas City for a few years. In 1906 or 1907 they moved to Montrose, CO., where Isaac was involved in the development of the area about the time the Gunnison Tunnel was being built. He actively developed an area that was named "Pepper's Gardens". He built a large storage cellar that would hold one hundred train car loads of potatoes to help local growers. They lived at 725 N. Third Street in Montrose. Isaac died 22 Sep 1923 (based on 73y 09m 22d) in Montrose, Montrose Co., CO. Emma died 12 May 1946 in Montrose, Montrose Co., CO. They were buried in Cedar Cemetery in Montrose, Montrose Co., CO. They had three children: 1. Lenna M. (Pepper) Toepffer 2. William Burton Pepper 3. Gertrude R. Pepper.
