The Condition of this Obligation is such, That if the above

 Daniel Sowash deceased, do make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods and chattle-
 s, rights and credits, of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the
 hands, possession, or knowledge of them the said ~~Margaret Sowash and~~

~~Joshua Budd~~ or unto the hands and possession of any other person or persons for them and
 the same so made do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, into the Regis-
 ter's Office, in the county of Westmoreland, at or before the ~~twenty second~~
 day of ~~June~~ next ensuing; and the same goods, chattels, rights,
 and credits, and all other the goods, chattels, rights, and credits of the said de-
 ceased, at the time of his death, which at any time after shall come to the

or unto the hands and possession of any other person or persons for them do
 well and truly administer according to law. And further do make, or cause
 to be made, a true and just account of their said administration at or before
