wealth of Pennsylvania to Daniel Harrold for a certain tract of land situate in
Kempfield township in the county aforesaid dated the first day of December in
one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven and enrolled in the Rolls Office
of the said commonwealth in Book No. 11 page 507 and the said Daniel Harrold
and Mary his wife did by their deed poll bearing date the thirteenth day of July
one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine & recorded in the office for record-
ing of Deeds in the county of Westmoreland in Book D. page 178 reference to the
aforesaid deeds will more fully and at large appear convey one hundred and
two acres of the aforesaid tract of land with the allowance for roads &c. unto John
Erbe for the consideration therein mentioned and the said John Erbe being since
deceased the said one hundred and two acres and allowance became the property
of the heirs of the said John Erbe Now know ye that the aforesaid Peter Erbe a son
