of the Borough of Irwin, County of Westmoreland
and State of Pennsylvania being of sound mind
and memory do hereby make, publish and de-

clare this to be my last Will and Testament.
in manner and form following hereby revoking any will or wills hereto
fore made by me: First I direct all my just debts and funeral ex-
penses to be fully paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently may
be after my decease. Second I devise and bequeath all my property
and estate, real, personal and mixed of what nature or kind down
and wherever the same shall be at the time of my death. To
my sister Rachel McCall and her husband Franklin McCall for
use during the term of their natural lives and at the death of one
of them to the survivor and at the decease of both of the above legatees:
I direct that all my real estate and whatever remains of the personal
property shall be sold by my Executors hereinafter named and the
proceeds divided as follows to wit: I give and bequeath one hundred
dollars to and for the benefit of the United Presbyterian
Church of Irwin Pa. I give and bequeath one hundred dollars to
George Albert Dowash. I give to Annie Large one hundred dollars.
All the remainder and residue of my Estate after the payment of the
above bequests I give and bequeath to George McCormick, Rachel
George wife of John George deceased, Joseph Brown, William
Bruce Barnhart, Elizabeth Davis and John McCormick and
Edward McCormick, Sons of Eli McCormick deceased Equally
than and share alike. Except the two last named John McCormick
and Edward McCormick who are to receive one share divided equally
between them. And lastly I do nominate and appoint John
Dowash of Penn Township, Westmoreland County and State of
Pennsylvania and Edward McCormick Esq of the Borough of
Irwin County and State aforesaid to be the Executors of this
my last Will and Testament and witness whereof I have here-
unto set my hand and seal this 30th day of August in the year
